## APPROACHING FROM THE NORTH

- Route 8 South to 76 East (at the central interchange)
- I-76 East to Market St./Mogadore Rd.
- Right at the bottom of the exit on to Market St.
- At the first light take a right on to Hilbish Rd.
- Follow through 3 traffic lights.
- Hilbish Rd. changes name to George Washington Blvd. when you cross over Triplett Blvd.
- If you wish to go to Soap Box Derby® Headquarters - Continue straight on George Washington Blvd. Turn right on Springfield Lake Blvd. (you will see Derby logos in the center of the road) and then take an immediate right onto the access road (Derby Downs Drive). Soap Box Derby Headquarters is the white brick building on the right side past the back of Derby Downs grandstands.
- If you wish to go to Topside - Continue straight up George Washington Blvd. Topside facilities are at the top of the hill on your right.

## APPROACHING FROM THE SOUTH

- I-77 North to 224 East towards Mogadore
- Turn left at the first traffic light (Route 241)
- If you wish to go to Soap Box Derby® Headquarters - Turn left on Springfield Lake Blvd. (you will see Derby logos in the center of the road) and then take an immediate right onto the access road (Derby Downs Drive). Soap Box Derby Headquarters is the white brick building on the right side past the back of Derby Downs grandstands.

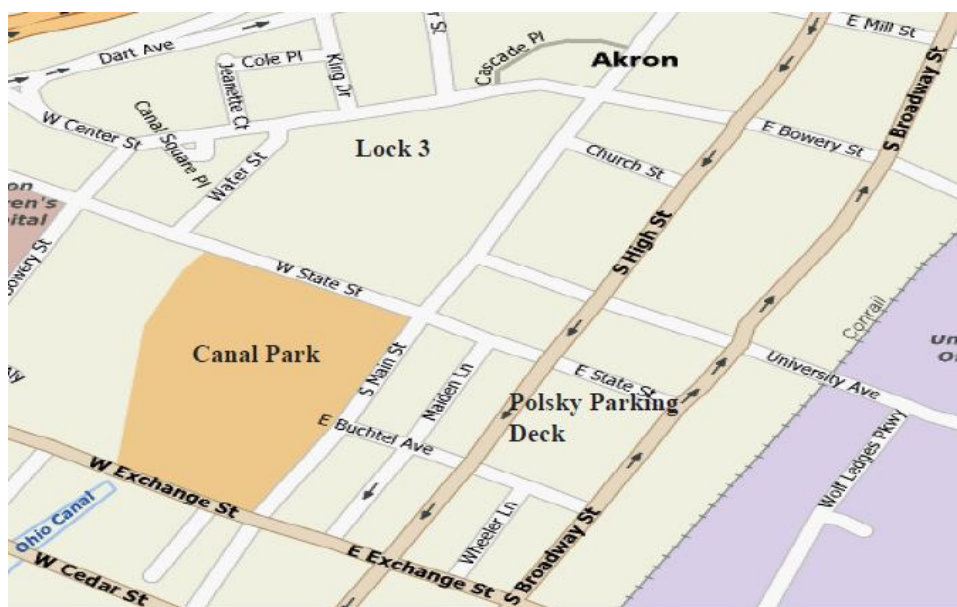

# GENERAL INFORMATION

## BUILD AND BATTLE

### Champ Build and Battle

One Champ from each of the Derby's 13 regions will be selected during Monday's opening ceremonies at Lock 3 to participate in the "Build and Battle" competition. Each Champ selected will pick one other Champ to help them build a Vintage Soap Box Derby car. The champ selected will race against the other 12 participants to see who is crowned "Build and Battle" Champion. Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers. The "Build" will take place Thursday, July 19, 5-7 p.m. during the Topside Show. The "Battle" will take place from 7-8 p.m. All necessary tools will be provided.

### Parent Build and Battle

(Only parents staying at a partner hotel are eligible. Please see hotel benefits for rules and regulations.) Three parents will be selected during Monday's opening ceremonies at Lock 3 to participate in the "Parent Build and Battle" competition. Each parent selected will pick one other parent to help them build a Vintage Soap Box Derby car. The parent selected will race against the other two participants to see who is crowned "Parent Build and Battle" Champion. The "Build" will take place Thursday, July 19, from 5-7 p.m. during the Topside Show. The "Battle" will take place from 7-8 p.m. All necessary tools will be provided.

## T-SHIRTS & JERSEYS

### T-Shirts and Jerseys

All Champions **MUST** wear their provided All-American Champion T-shirts on the following days: Sunday through Thursday, July 14-18. On Saturday, July 20, all Champions must wear their provided All-American Champion Jersey. Please keep in mind that the shirts may **NOT** be altered.

## ALIGNMENT BADGES

### Alignment Badges

Each Champ is provided one additional badge for alignment days. The badge will be included in the Champ bag and can only be used to get into Topside during scheduled alignment days. Scheduled alignment days are Sunday and Friday.

## BANNERS

### Banners

Families are encouraged to bring banners to support their champs. Banners should be no higher than 3' and no longer than 6'. Do not hang banners on Derby Downs fencing before 8 a.m. on Sunday, July 14. Violations of the above will result in the removal of the banners.

## CHAMP CAR MESSAGES

### Champ Car Messages

Want to write and give a message for a Champ wishing him/her "good luck" in Saturday's race? Blank message cards can be picked up, filled out, and given to the volunteers at the office tent behind the Blue Hall of Fame and Museum Building. These messages will be placed in the Champs' cars for them to read on Saturday morning before the race. All messages are due by Thursday at 7 p.m..

## WATER STATIONS

### Water Stations

There will be water stations located throughout Derby Downs for your convenience. We encourage you to bring a reusable water bottle that can be refilled at these stations. The stations will be located at Champ check-in, office tent, within Topside (more than one station), at the starting line and in run out.

## FIRST AID

### First Aid

There are first aid kits available to guests located at the Office Tent, Blue Hall of Fame and Museum Building, White Building, starting line, finish line bridge, and run out. For medical emergencies, an ambulance will be located in run out during all racing events. In case of a medical emergency dial 9-1-1 and the ambulance will be dispatched from run out.
