# WHAT

## ***STORY OF THE FIRSTENERGY ALL-AMERICAN SOAP BOX DERBY***

The idea of the Soap Box Derby grew from a photographic assignment of Dayton, Ohio newsman Myron Scott. He covered a race of boy-built cars in his home community and was so impressed with the event that he acquired a copyright for the idea and went in search of a sponsor for a similar program on a national level.

Chevrolet liked Scott's proposal and agreed to sponsor the first All-American Soap Box Derby in Dayton in 1934. The following year, the race was moved to Akron because of its central location and hilly terrain. The first race in the city was run on Tallmadge Hill.

In 1936, Chevrolet and Akron's civic leaders recognized the need for a permanent track site for the youth racing classic. That year, through the labors of the Works Progress Administration (WPA), Derby Downs in southeast Akron became a reality.

The Soap Box Derby ran continuously from its inception until the onset of World War II. After a four-year suspension, the youth racing event resumed in Akron in 1946, and had been held every year until 2020 when the racing season was interrupted by the pandemic. From its beginning through 1970, the Soap Box Derby was open to boys only. Girls began racing in 1971.

After Chevrolet discontinued its sponsorship after the 1972 race, all trademarks and copyrights for the event were transferred to the former Akron Area Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber itself managed the 1973 Soap Box Derby, then in 1974 assigned rights for the All-American program to the Akron Jaycees. To operate the Derby program, the Jaycees established International Soap Box Derby Inc., the organization that continues today. The corporation's affairs are administered by a board of directors of community leaders from Akron and other cities.

In 1976, the All-American Derby program created a new Junior division, in which youngsters aged 10 through 12 competed in Kit Cars. In 1981, for the first time, some of the Junior champions raced in cars built with fiberglass body shells provided by Derby headquarters; beginning in 1984, a similar shell was available for senior cars. In 1992, the novice Stock Car division was introduced in which 7- to 13-year-olds build ready-to-assemble fiberglass cars. Super Stock ready-to-assemble cars for larger youngsters replaced the Kit Cars in 1995. There will be three racing divisions on Saturday: the Stock Car, Super Stock and the traditional Masters Divisions. Division contestants will compete for a share of \$36,000 in scholarships.

Since 2012, FirstEnergy Corp., the Akron-based diversified energy company, has been the organization's title sponsor. Additional program income comes from race city agreement license fees, sales of Derby car kits and other supplies, as well as financial contributions from businesses, charitable foundations and individuals.

# WHERE

## DERBY DOWNS

Derby Downs is celebrating its 85<sup>rd</sup> birthday this summer! Akron's famous Derby Downs was built as part of the Works Progress Administration (WPA) in 1936. It has been the home of the All-American Soap Box Derby for 81 of the event's 83 years. The track was built after Derby officials and Akron civic leaders determined that the annual racing classic needed a permanent facility. It lies against a natural hill on the eastern fringes of Akron Fulton International Airport.

Derby Downs is a sports arena that is a center of activity and interest for Derby rallies and local races leading up to All-American Soap Box Derby Day, as well as corporate outings and special events.

On the west side of the track's run-out area is the Derby organization's headquarters building, which was completed in 1992. The Derby program's year-round administrative staff operates from the headquarters.

There is a garage and service area at the top of the hill which serves as car storage and the "service pit" area during Race Week. A storage building on George Washington Boulevard, funded by Summit County, was added in 2001. The Hall of Fame and Museum, containing many of the world championship cars over the years and plaques for Hall of Fame inductees, is displayed in this building. The white Topside facility is the site of the Derby program's assembly and shipping operations for the car kits and other components purchased by race organizations and individual contestants.

The grounds are owned by the City of Akron, which in 1999 contributed \$1.3 million to replace the aging wooden grandstands with metal bleachers and to repave the entire length of the track. The track was repaved in 2009 and again for the 2021 race. Other 2021 improvements include a new sidewalk on the west side of the track and new signage has been installed around the facility.

In 2000, a two-deck steel structure replaced the three-level bridge that had stood over the finish line since 1937. The bridge, funded by a \$250,000-grant from Summit County, houses race control operations, judging, record-keeping and media covering the event.

The current bridge is 35 feet, seven inches past the former finish line, which lengthened the official track to 989 feet, four inches. To obtain the propulsion that produces exciting races, the track's decline is separated into three stages. The first 53.75 feet carry a 16 percent grade, meaning a drop at the rate of 16 feet for every 100 feet. There follows a six percent grade for the next 530 and a two percent drop over the remaining 405.5 feet.

The Starting Line Facility was added in 2012 through a donation from Marous Brothers Construction, and a permanent sound system for the track facility was installed in 2013 through a grant from the Northern Ohio Golf Charities Foundation. A new addition in 2019 was the electronic board on the bridge to display messages and race results, through contributions from the Corbin Foundation and individual donors.

The track itself is as safe as experience and engineering can make it. The 30-foot-wide track is bordered by guardrails. The 1,200-foot run-out area beyond the finish line is an additional safety precaution. Parallel lines on the full length of the track serve as guides for the young drivers.

**TRACK RECORDS:** At the pre-2000 track length of 953 feet, nine inches, Ed Myers of Conshohocken, Pa., set the track record of 27.10 seconds in 1974. He finished third in the All-American that year. The record at the current length of 989 feet, four inches is 28.24 seconds in 2004 by Hillary Pearson of Kansas City, Mo., who went on to win the 2004 Masters division championship.

## ***THE ROAD TO AKRON***

The road to Akron can be winning just one single race, or it can be an entire season of racing on many tracks. There are hundreds of local Soap Box Derby racing events held around the globe every year. However a champion qualifies for the All-American race in Akron, it's certain to be a fun-filled experience with memories to last a lifetime.

There are two qualifying roads leading to the FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby each July. Communities all across the world hold local Soap Box Derby races. Local races are held once a year and are licensed by the FirstEnergy All-American Soap Box Derby. These are dedicated races for children who reside within the community sponsoring the local race. Racers are only permitted to compete in one local race per season and can only become a champ once in each division. The winner of each division of a local race is in Akron to represent his or her race city to compete against champs from across the world.

The other route to Akron is a well-traveled road. Rally races are held throughout the year on weekends. Participants can race in any All-American sanctioned rally race anywhere in the world and accumulate points. The rally season starts June 1 each year and continues through May 31.

Drivers who accumulate certain levels of points during the season and meets all criteria will be invited to the All-American Soap Box Derby Championship race to compete against other rally champions for the world title. There are 12 rally districts in the United States plus an International district. The rally champ represents the district in which they reside.

Both categories of champions are invited to the national competition. During race week, all champs will participate in the same activities. On race day, local champs will compete against each other, as well as rally champs competing against each other. At the end of race day, there will be three All-American local world champs and three rally world champs.

## ***WHO RACES IN EACH DIVISION?***

There will be races in three divisions on Saturday. The **Stock Car** category, introduced in 1992, features a ready-to-assemble race car similar to popular ready-to-assemble desks and other furniture. The Stock division is open to boys and girls ages 7 through 13.

In 1995, the **Super Stock Car** division was added. These cars are similar to the Stock division, but are larger to accommodate larger youngsters ages 9 through 18.

The **Masters** division cars are the traditional sleeker, more sophisticated cars. In 2000, the Derby organization introduced the first car kit for the Masters division. Masters participants are 10 through 20 years old.
